- \$100k grant
- One 3-bedroom home
- Very-low to low-income family
- Anticipated finish date: mid-November

Sitka: "Hitx'i Sáani" (Little Houses)

- \$150k grant
- 12 apartments, incl. a caretaker cabin & community room
- Sitka's first permanent supportive housing development



Soldotna: "Tatum Mutual 'Self-Help' Project"



- \$100k grant
- 9 homes
- Very low and low-income families
- Owners chip in sweat equity to help build their home



Nome: "HomePlate Nome"



- \$150k grant
- 15 apartments
- Permanent supportive housing
- Move-in anticipated by year-end



Wasilla: "Aspen House"



- \$150k grant
- 40 homes
- Low and middle-income seniors
- Anticipated completion in November 2024



Juneau: "Cordova Street Apartments"

- \$100k grant
- 7 apartments
- Low-income domestic violence survivors
- Residents moved in in September
